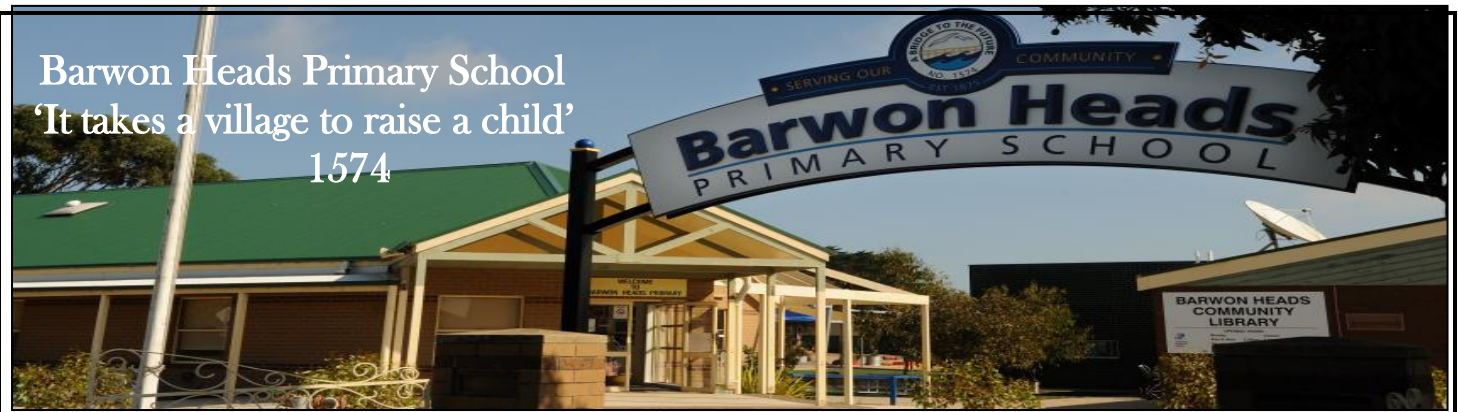

The refurbishments to our school continue to roll on with the library being painted and recarpeted this week. I would like to thank Mrs Browne and all of the parents who assisted in moving and packing to allow the works to begin on time. The community's support during this time has been greatly appreciated.

Supervision of students in the yard has been revamped at BHPS. We are trialling a new model with 4 designated areas and a teacher allocated to each area in the yard. This model has already proven to be a success with teachers being more accessible for students needing support. Also student/teacher connections are on the increase with students interacting with more teachers other than their classroom teacher.

TRAFFIC - can be tricky around schools and I would like to remind everyone about being vigilant at pick up and drop off times. I ask that all parents remind students of safety - particularly leaving the lane way in Hopgood Place, around Clifford Parade/Reid Street intersection and Grove Road. Riding in the middle of the road is dangerous and we ask that all cyclists take extra care. Drivers please observe parking and speed limits of 40km/h during school times.
